New Equipment for Boston!

After last year's record breaking winter, Keolis and the Massachusetts Bay Transport Authority (MBTA) recently unveiled their plan to combat the winter conditions in Boston: around 50 new pieces of new snow removal equipment to keep the commuter rail running. The new machines total almost nine million USD and include all types of vehicles, from small tractors to larger heavy-duty ones built specifically to sweep the snow off the rails. It is part of the "winter resiliency plan" announced by the Massachusetts Governor earlier this year. Keolis Commuter Services will also add a new passenger information centre and a weather desk, and has already started training employees to perform snow related duties.

Sweden: New Contract in Skogsblomman

On November 5, Keolis Sverige announced a new contract win in Skogsblomman (North of Stockholm). This is the second recent win in the Värmland region, as Keolis won a tender in Karlstad just last month. Starting on July 1, 2016, Keolis will operate around 40 additional buses, all of which fossil free. This new contract will run for five years (with a possible two-year extension) and will be official after the ten day appeal period is over.

Norway: Contract Extension and Phase 3 Begins in Bergen



Keolis Norge's contract to operate the Bybanen, or light rail service in Bergen, was recently extended to July 2018 (with a possible additional one year extension). Phase 3 is currently under construction and includes a large new depot and seven kilometre line extension that contains six new tunnels and seven new

stations, including the Airport Terminal. The new fully covered stabling area will be one of Keolis' biggest in Europe: 40 trams can be held on eight tracks covering a length of 300m. In the next few months, eight new Stadler trams (42m long) will arrive to bring the fleet total to 28 trams.

EFFIA Parking Signs a New Contract in Southern France



The city of Marseille (Southern France) signed a new contract with EFFIA to manage ten public car parking lots in Marseille for a total of 1,050 parking spots. This seven-year contract started on October 26 and will have cumulated revenue of eight million euros. EFFIA plans to invest 1.14 million euros to improve

the accessibility, signage and parking equipment.
